LIFE for the SIGNS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

- Unpaid or paid very little; not in control of their finances
- Employer is holding identification/travel documents
- Secretive regarding details of their life; answers seems rehearsed/scripted
- Deprived of food, water, sleep or medical care
- Signs of physical abuse such as burn marks, bruises or cuts
- Submissive, fearful, or anxious; avoids eye contact
- Cannot freely contact friends or family
- Juveniles engaged in commercial sex
- Unexplained absences from normal activities or school

if you suspect trafficking and can speak with a potential vic<mark>tim</mark> without jeopardizing their safety:

- Can you leave your job or home if you want to?
- Have you been hurt or threatened if you try to leave or stop?
- Are you allowed to keep the money you earn?
- How did you get those cuts/scars/burns?
- Do you live with your employer? Where do you sleep and eat?
- Do you have your passport/identification? Who has it?
