MISSION

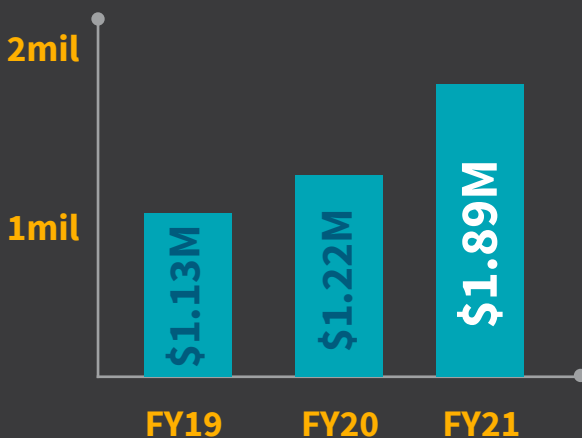
Life for Innocent partners with communities to rescue, restore and renew children affected by trafficking.

By Year

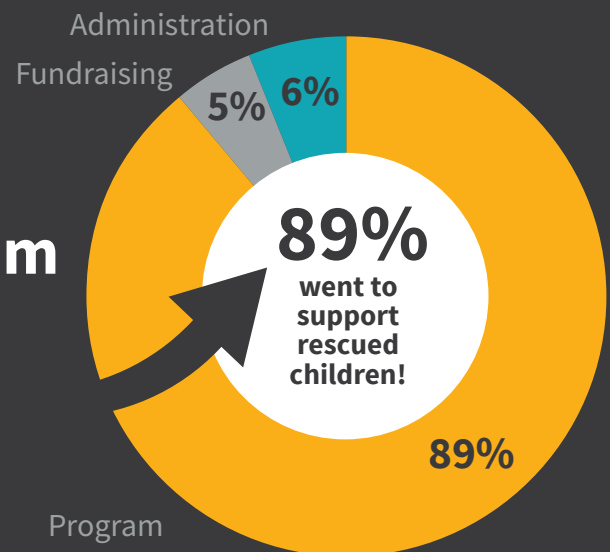

- Age range is 4-9 years old.
- From Nepal, Burma, Bangladesh, Bhutan and other countries in South Asia.
- Primary physical needs are food, sleep, shelter and medical care to address abuse, malnutrition, and neglect.
- Primary emotional needs are establishing trust, safety and a sense of self-worth.

Intake

After children are rescued, LFTI first provides intake services like medical exams and obtaining ID documents. The team also transports children to LFTI transition homes, providing a safe place to recover, heal, and grow.

Transition

LFTI operates over 8 dozen transition homes for rescued boys and girls, with local staff who speak the same language. Children stay between 2-6 months based on individual needs, and receive food, clothes, education and counseling. To establish stability and safety, the staff encourage the kids to simply eat, sleep, and play. If kinship adoption isn't possible, children are matched with Forever Families.

Adoption

LFTI's adoptions make our approach especially unique. Parents are recruited through partner churches across South Asia and are vetted for two years. They get to meet and spend time with their child and eventually bring them home permanently. Our follow-up process ensures ongoing support for kids and parents. Additionally, all children and parents have lifetime access to LFTI trauma counselors so they have every chance to thrive.

BY THE NUMBERS

\$1,485 - All post-rescue services for one child (food, clothes, housing, medical care, education, counseling, and adoption)

\$6,000 - Food for all children in a transition home for 6 months

\$15,000 - A new van to transport children safely to and from a transition home

\$32,000 - Renovate a building into a children's transition home

\$43,000 - All clothing (two outfits and a pair of shoes) for every LFTI child in one year
